#### EPCAMR Staff and Program Staff Highlights (August 2006 to October 2006) Regional Coordinator's (RC) Highlights

- EPCAMR Staff prepared for and coordinated the 8th Annual Pennsylvania AML Reclamation Conference. From seven states, 200 people attended the conference, which offered 35 workshops provided by over 40 presenters.
- Conducted 6 watershed tours with Keystone College, Penn-State's AgLEAP Program, Wyoming Valley Artists, a Delaware Valley College representative, Senator Santorum's Legislative staff and Luzerne County's Children Service Center respectively.
- EPCAMR was awarded a \$1,528 Scranton Area Foundation Award for art supplies
- EPCAMR was awarded a **\$20K** PA DEP Environmental Education Grant
- EPCAMR Staff met with 2 consultants interested in culm pile reclamation
- EPCAMR Staff conducted 3 COALS Illegal Dumpsite surveys with Steve Bartos and other PA DEP Waste Management Staff.

## Watershed Outreach Coordinator's (WOC) Highlights

- EPCAMR Staff assessed AML impacted streams in Luzerne County for flood damage and created a GIS Layer to facilitate cleanup in Luzerne County and assessed 2 discharges (McCauley Mtn Discharge, Columbia Co. and Glen Nan Discharge, Luzerne Co.)
- EPCAMR Staff, 4 EPCAMR Board Members and new WPCAMR Watershed Outreach Coordinator, Andy McAllister, tended the booth and spoke with thousands of citizens at the Bloomsburg Fair. EPCAMR also received \$74 in donations.
- Printed 3 GIS Maps for municipalities and watershed groups and updated the PA AMD AML GIS CD to v.6.2 with topographic maps and 2001 Aerial photos for all of PA live from PASDA.
- Began an Anthracite Region Mine Pool GIS Data Layer adapted from EMARR files and Scarlift Maps.
- EPCAMR was awarded a **\$20K** WPWP Foundation Grant for AML Trust Fund GIS Work

### Municipal GIS Technician's (MGT) Highlights

- Conducted NFWF GIS Workshops at Mt. Carmel Township, Northumberland Co., Laflin Borough, Luzerne Co., Lackawanna County Council on Economic Development and Butler Township, Luzerne Co.
- Completed NFWF GIS Maps for the following: Mt. Carmel Township, Northumberland Co., Clinton Township, Wayne Co., Wilkes-Barre City, Laflin Borough, Luzerne Co., Forest City Borough, Susquehanna Co., North Union Township, Schuylkill Co., Butler Township, Luzerne Co. and Crestwood School District, Luzerne Co.

## Watershed Development Coordinator's (WDC) Highlights

- Completed the project on Avondale Hill with a community cookout. 40 volunteers donated 766 hours of their time to design and construct an industrial metal art piece, to create a large perennial garden, and to build a community bulleting board. Gathered resources for the entire project equal \$1,167.00 of direction donations and \$15,600.00 of in-kind donations.
- Began a water sampling program with local volunteers from Plymouth Twp. and in cooperation with PA DEP BAMR Wilkes-Barre Office. They will collect at least a year's worth of data on the Glen Nan Discharge.
- The South Street Cleanup in Nanticoke, PA occurred on 7/22. 25 volunteers worked for 2 hours and collected 47 bags of trash (~1880 pounds), 23 pieces of furniture and appliances, 108 tires collected, and 1350 pounds of scrap metal recycled. More litter remains at this site and the Nanticoke Terrace Residents' Association is planning another cleanup.
- Conducted 5 AMD Tie Dye Workshops at Blue Ridge Elementary School (92 students), Carbon Co. Env. Ed. Center (35 students), Luzerne County Mental Health Department (60 students), Moon Lake Park's Family Weekend Fun Days (50 attendees) and Summer Splash with the Wilkes-Barre Boulevard Townhome Residents (60 youth 4 times).

#### Anthracite Art Intern (AAI) Highlights

- Gallery showing of the Anthrascapes Art Exhibit for the week of August 6<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> at the Third Floor Gallery in Arts YOUniverse.
- Baking AMD sludge into AMD Iron Oxide Pigment to supply to local artists
- Coordinated with artists from the AFA Gallery in Scranton for another art exhibit
