Regional Coordinator's (RC) Highlights

- Provided <u>Technical Assistance</u> to Laflin Boro & Newport Township on available grant opportunities for stream restoration, stream remediation, & AML reclamation projects in their respective municipalities
- Submitted Quarterly Report for Bear Creek AMD Remediation Project, Dauphin Co.
- Met with Schuylkill CD and other partners on the Audenreid AMD Remediation Project, Schuylkill Co.
