AMR Program Staff 4th Quarter Highlights (July 2009 – September 2009)

Executive Director's Highlights

- Picked up several costumes of our AMD Avengers vs. The Pollution Posse from Barbara Gavlick-Costumes by Barbara, to be used in the Fall 2009 when we do Education Programs in the schools on AMD. Received another award from the Scranton Area Foundation to continue the development of the Theatrical Performance.
- Partnered with Wilkes University's 2009 Summer Freshman Orientation Class and worked with 25 students to pour additional batches of iron oxide chalk for our educational programs
- Provided Letters of support for 6 groups submitting Growing Greener Projects including Schuylkill Headwaters Association, Earth Conservancy, Marywood University, Catawissa Creek Restoration Association, Schuylkill Conservation District & the Pennsylvania State University.
- Received donated 10 gallons of anti-graffiti paint and rollers from PA DOT for the AML Beautification Project and graffiti removal project at the Avondale Mine Site, Plymouth Township, Luzerne County; EPCAMR interns will be covering up all graffiti at the site, on buildings, and the State underpass that runs over the Susquehanna Warrior Trail
- Closed out the PA DEP 319 Program Grant including the additional funds received for the Fence at SCRA's Site 15 AMD Treatment Site. Received paperwork the next grant award, a 3 year agreement instead of 1 year. Submitted a Request for Working Capital and 2 Reimbursements.
- Conducted an AMD Tie-Dye Outreach Program for the Carbon County Conservation District's Nature Camp in partnership with the Carbon County Environmental Education Center staff at Hickory Run State Park; 30 students reached
- Prepared 37 individual letters for each of the Legislators (Representatives and Senators) in the EPCAMR Region where we are actively involved in watershed projects in partnership with our Conservation Districts and their Watershed Specialist staff people; The letters were in support of dedicated funding to support these positions at the Conservation Districts; An additional letter was mailed to PA DEP Secretary John Hanger
- EPCAMR Executive Director worked with First National Bank to finalize the 90-day short term loan of \$30,000 to keep EPCAMR operational until grant reimbursements come in to provide a cash flow balance
- EPCAMR Executive Director prepared 10 press releases and had Mike post them to our website and our FaceBook account; All releases can be found at <u>www.orangewaternetwork.org</u> in the News Scroll. Topics included Avondale Cleanup and 140th Mind Disaster Anniversary Ceremony, The AMD Avengers Costumes and Theatrical Play development, Orion Society Award, Iron Oxide Chalk availability, ARIPPA Technical Symposium presentation and the 11the Annual AMR Conference.
