AMR Program Staff 1st Quarter Highlights (January 2010 – April 2010)

Executive Director's Highlights

- Submitted a "Cultivating Tree Trout and Understanding AMD Impacts in the Wyoming Valley" Aquatic Resources \$5000 grant application to the PA Fish & Boat Commission with the assistance of our intern Leigh Ann
- Completed a 2010-2011 Living2Serve draft Grant Application for **\$3000** and forwarded it to Janice to submit for the Huber Breaker Anthracite Miner's AML Memorial Park Landscaping and Paver Project. W-B CTC FFA Club was recently awarded **\$4000** grant on the Avondale AML Community Gardens Project
- EPCAMR Executive Director was selected by a panel of professional peers from the area for his environmental work in Luzerne County, the Region, as Top 40 Under 40 Top Professionals sponsored by the Times Leader.
- EPCAMR is now a partner of the PA DCNR iConserve initiative and the EPCAMR Executive Director was also chosen as a PAiCon by PA DCNR and is featured on the <u>www.iConserve.org</u> website
- EPCAMR received a **\$500** Environmental Education grant Award from Dominion and the Western PA Conservancy to conduct AMD Outreach programs in Tioga and Lycoming County school districts impacted by AMD
- ARIPPA is providing a \$20,000 (\$10,000 to each Coalition) donation in recognition
 of their 20th Anniversary. EPCAMR and WPCAMR will develop and administer a
 mini-grants program open to community groups working on AMD/AML Projects and
 are supportive of the beneficial use of coal ash for abandoned mine reclamation
 projects.
- Worked with the Huber Breaker Preservation Society membership President and their web master at the EPCAMR Technical Assistance Center to update the <u>www.huberbreaker.org</u> website; Prepared a **\$2000** grant to the Luzerne Foundation on behalf of the HBPS
- Provided the Schuylkill River Restoration Fund a Letter of Intent to pursue a \$100,000 proposal in the Upper Schuylkill River Watershed to continue the mapping mine pools
- Completed and submitted a **\$10,000** PA American Water Grant for Community Outreach on the Old Forge AMD Remediation Project, Lackawanna/Luzerne Cos
- EPCAMR was awarded a **\$500** cash award from the Bear Creek Charter Foundation to assist us with purchasing a high end digital video camera
