### AMR Program Staff 3rd Quarter Highlights (December 2012 – February 2013)

### **Executive Director and General Staff Highlights**

- Presented the Mine Pool Mapping (MPM) Initiative to the Scranton Rotary. EPCAMR staff presented the Western Middle MPM Report to the SCRA and Solomon Creek CHP Report at public meetings.
- EPCAMR was partially awarded the ARIPPA Reclaimed Areas GIS Proposal at a \$3,000 Pilot Study level with the potential to continue the project. Recently the study was put on hold.
- Wilkes-Barre Career & Technology Center was awarded an additional \$2500 through the Future Farmers of America (FFA) via the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture (USDA) for FY2012-2013 to continue working on the Huber Miner's Memorial Park. EPCAMR helped write the grant and helps coordinate the project.
- Completed the Solomon Creek Coldwater Conservation Plan (SCCCP) and presented it at a public meeting. Completed a \$15,000 Cora Brooks Foundation grant proposal for the Solomon Creek Implementation Habitat Improvement Project (SCIHP). Submitted a very similar grant application for \$10,000 to the Foundation for PA Watersheds for match.
- EPCAMR staff prepared draft Mine Map Grant application package to the PA DEP Mine Subsidence Insurance (MSI) Fund for ~\$255,000 to scan, georeference, and digitize GIS files from a backlog of thousands of maps that the state has in its possession. The MSI would like to update their website, especially for the Anthracite Region, to aide homeowners in knowing the abandoned underground mine subsidence potential under their home and purchasing insurance if their home could potentially be affected. The grant is due March 15<sup>th</sup>.
- EPCAMR and LRCA staff completed the Lower Lackawanna Watershed Restoration Action Plan (LLWRAP) and executive summary. Began distribution of the summary to key legislators and DEP to begin an implementation strategy.
- EPCAMR staff participated in AMR Conference Calls, monthly, to coordinate the AMR Conference with the conference planning committee and built up the treatminewater.com website with details on the conference as they are sorted out.
- EPCAMR Executive Director completed a \$25,000 Shale Gas Innovation Contest Proposal to continue to work on our 3D Underground Mine Pool Mapping Initiative throughout Northeastern PA and potentially rest of PA's mining impacted areas.

#### **Program Manager Highlights**

- Continued to update mine pool GIS files in the Northern & Western Middle Anthracite Fields and began a 3D Mine Pool Model for the Lackawanna Valley.
- Created 1 published map file, 4 maps, 2 GIS, and 5 statistical databases for partners.
- EPCAMR staff sampled 16 boreholes in the Lackawanna Valley, 26 boreholes in the Wyoming Valley, monitored 1 treatment system, and measured flow on 4 discharges monthly.
- Measured flow and chemistry on 2 more discharges, treatment systems, & upstream and downstream points on the Loyalsock Creek with Sullivan CCD as part of a tour for conservation officials. Presented info on the Bernice Mine Pool.
- Updated 2 GIS and 2 statistical databases for partners. Continued to update and produce figures for the LLWRAP and SCCCP.
- Filled 2 iron oxide orders from EPCAMR Online Store.
- Provided an EPCAMR Program Review for the Non Point Source Liaison Workgroup: Resource Extraction Sub-Committee for Federal Fiscal Year 2012 (October 1, 2011 – September 30, 2012) and submitted it to Donna Carnahan, PA DEP 319 Program. This also serves as a start for the 2012 EPCAMR Annual Report.
- Suggested to the PA DEP 319 Program that a section of Solomon Creek (Sugar Notch Run Headwaters) be removed from the Impaired Waters List.
- Updated <u>www.huberbreaker.org</u>, <u>www.epcamr.org</u> and <u>www.treatminewater.com</u>. Administered the EPCAMR facebook page and Google Apps for Nonprofits account.
