# AMR Program Staff Highlights since last Meeting (March – May & June – August) Partners and Places in bold

#### **Executive Director and General Staff Highlights**

- EPCAMR staff participated in Rail Riders Community Organization Promotional Day, the ACT Conference by Foundation for PA Watersheds, GIS Discovery Day at Kings College, hosted a Datashed Workshop, and hosted EPCAMR Quarterly Board Mtg.
- Worked with EPCAMR Volunteer Coordinator to compile volunteer request forms. The
  forms indicate interest in 17 different volunteer descriptions posted to VolunteerMatch and
  other sites that solicit volunteers. To date EPCAMR has a base of 53 volunteers that we
  can call on for various tasks.
- Provided PA AML Resolution template to Mike to forward along to our Conservation
  Districts, watershed groups, and reclamation-related partners in the EPCAMR Region to
  encourage them to pass a resolution; EPCAMR Intern compiled a database all of County
  Officials in the EPCAMR Region and sent the resolution to this list as well.
- EPCAMR Staff sat in on AMR Conference Calls, monthly, to coordinate the AMR Conference with the conference planning committee and built up the treatminewater.com website with details on the conference as they are sorted out.
- EPCAMR staff submitted 3 grants: ~\$342K Mine Mapping Program to the DEP Mine Subsidence Insurance Fund, \$8K PA American Water Company for Solomon Creek Habitat Improvement Project and \$2K for 2 Year Waterboxx Research on AML Grant to the ACCT.
- EPCAMR staff collaborated to transition our Grant Tracking System into QuickBooks for Nonprofits 2013. Several hours were spent learning the software and applying it to specific programs and situations. Setup the accounting program to mirror our 990's.
- Coordinated with the **Hicks Creek** Watershed Association, Exeter Borough, and all partners involved with the Hicks Creek Natural Stream Design & Construction Project;
- Designed a webpage on EPCAMR.org for our PA Fish & Boat Commission Tackle Loaner Program and some updates to posts and pages on TreatMineWater.com
- Requested a letter from the Superintendent of the Wilkes-Barre Area School District, Dr. Bernie Prevuznak to support EPCAMR's renewal as an Educational Improvement Organization (EIO) under the PA DCED Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC)
- Signed on to a letter, along with several other partnering organizations to preserve a special part of Penn's Woods from gas development; The tract of the Loyalsock State Forest in **Lycoming County** includes places of ecological and recreational significance.
- Attended a QuickBooks for Non Profits Training put on by the Baer Center in Pittsburgh.
- Worked with a consultant for a large Southern California Clothing Company to provide him with 3 pounds of iron oxide pigment as a trial run. Results were good and he asked for enormous quantities. EPCAMR was working with him to provide capital to purchase processing equipment that could speed up the processing.
- EPCAMR staff coordinated 2 cleanups of Nockley's Tributary to Solomon Creek.
- EPCAMR and WPCAMR staff coordinated ARIPPA Reclamation Presentations and Fundraiser and attended a Luzerne Co. Council Meeting to benefit AMD Cleanup in Lackawanna River.
- EPCAMR staff met with several legislators to inform them of EPCAMR's efforts and SRBC and LVC's intentions to submit Act 13 proposals to the CFA.
- EPCAMR and WPCAMR staff prepared for and coordinated the 15<sup>th</sup> Annual AMR Conference at the Ramada Conference and Golf Hotel in State College, PA.
   Approximately 100 attendees with 25 presentations over 2.5 days including a preconference advocacy workshop and Mayfly Award Winner, Bruce Leavitt.

#### **Program Manager Highlights**

- Participated in an Anthracite Region CDWS Meeting at the Pottsville DMO, an Audenreid Treatment System Technical Assistance Meeting, and provided historical statistics on AMD Treatment costs in the Schuylkill River Watershed.
- Installed QuickBooks on 2 EPCAMR computers, learned the program via a volunteer "crash course" and tested new "e-mail campaign" app to find some sobering results
- Sampled 1 treatment system in the Wyoming Valley monthly, downloaded transducer data for the OFB discharge bi-weekly, researched base WQ for the Lewis AMD Treatment System, Sullivan Co., & visited the Silver Creek AMD Treatment System, Schuylkill Co.
