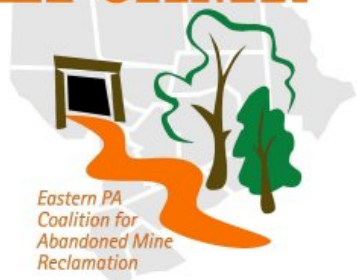

Education and Outreach

- Met with John Dawes-Program Manager for the Foundation for PA Watersheds, Diane Schrauth and Andrew Johnson-Program Managers for the William Penn Foundation and took them on a tour of abandoned mine drainage sites in Luzerne County.
- Conducted an Iron Oxide Chalk Talk Program at John Marshall Elementary School in Scranton, PA with approximately **60** 4th graders.
